- 2. Able to Rent / Reserve Online





RESEARCH PROCESS



Conduct Online Research First (84.50%)

Contact Community First (15.50%)





What this means:

84.5% conduct research online prior to contacting the community. Renters today want to find enough information online to narrow down their options. Community websites need to be a "one stop shop" experience for renters.

At this stage prospects want to see what a community has to offer, but they are not ready to make a commitment or even connect with a live person. Interestingly, the ability to communicate with staff is extremely important, but they want to do it on their own terms.
